Long history of volunteer service and experience at local, state, and national levels of the credit union movement

Has served as an elected official of VyStar Credit Union for 43 years. Currently serving as Treasurer for VyStar Credit Union.

Has been part of VyStar's growth from \$5.9 million in assets and serving 16,500 members to over \$3.9 billion in assets today and serving over 350,000 members. VyStar is currently the 17th largest credit union in the nation.

At VyStar; has served on the Credit Committee, Supervisory Committee and the Board of Directors. Has served as VyStar's Board Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary. Local Level: Served as Chapter President, Vice President, Program Chairman, and Education Advisory Committee Member.

State Level: Served on the Florida Credit Union League Board of Directors for 21 years and as Chairman of the Board, First Vice Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer.

National Level: Served as the Credit Union National Association (CUNA) National Director from the State of Florida for 15 years and as a member of the CUNA Government Affairs Committee and the CUNA Human Resources Committee.

In 1993, received the Volunteer of the Year Award from the Florida Credit Union League and was inducted into the Florida Credit Union League's Hall of Fame.

Ralph Story retired from the Department of the Navy after 38 years of military and civilian service. Throughout his career and retirement, he has served the credit union movement and the defense credit union community in every capacity, including his selection in 2005, as the first volunteer Chairman of the Defense Credit Union Council.
